

Birth Parent Counsellor Job Posting

JFJ Hope Centre (JFJ), founded in 1948, is a thriving organization with a passion for children and families. Our mission states: *Inspired by faith, we journey with individuals and families to create a community where everyone feels equipped and supported to lead and love their family. We are privileged to partner with birth parents, adoptive families, and those waiting to adopt.*

With an emphasis on hope and compassion, JFJ offers a broad range of parenting supports and programs, unplanned pregnancy counselling, adoption services and educational programs.

JFJ Hope Centre Adoption Services has been licensed by the Government of Ontario to facilitate private, domestic adoptions since 1986.

We are currently seeking a caring, compassionate and qualified individual to join our team. The successful candidate will be responsible for providing Birth Parent Services to women and men considering private, voluntary adoption for their children. This is a part-time contract position that requires a flexible schedule and reports to the Program Director and Executive Director.

Responsibilities:

- Provide options counselling to birth parents who are making a decision for their child or expected child.
- Providing support and education to birth parents exploring and/or pursuing an adoption plan for their child or expected child.
- Maintaining accurate documentation as required by the Ministry concerning all clients.
- Managing all aspects of a case for clients choosing adoption including, but not limited to:
 - Ensuring clients receive appropriate education and information regarding all aspects of adoption.
 - Ensuring the rights of both birth parents are respected.
 - Ensuring that accurate and complete social and medical histories are obtained.
 - Liaising with hospital staff regarding birth and placement plans.
 - Attending the hospital to provide support at the time of the child's birth.
 - Accompanying birth parents in initial meeting with adoptive couple.
 - Accompanying birth parents to lawyer appointments for consent signing, when required.
 - Providing post-adoption counseling and support, as requested by clients.
 - Liaising with the provincial adoption unit and other adoption professionals as required.
 - Providing pre and post adoption grief support.

While most meetings can be pre-planned around client and counsellor schedules, the birth parent counsellor needs to be able to prioritize availability to clients at key times in the adoption process.

Qualifications and skills:

- Possess a Bachelor of Social Work, Master of Social Work, BScNursing, Psychotherapist or equivalent;
- Registration with their respective Professional College is required;
- Experience in adoption services, child welfare or with a Pregnancy Care Centre is an asset
- A car and valid driver's license with the ability to travel
- Strong social work skills
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Strong organizational skills
- Excellent communications skills, both written and verbal
- Work independently, self-motivated and have the ability to prioritize tasks
- Excellent administrative skills, record keeping and knowledge of Office 365
- Fluent in English
- Team player
- A commitment to JFJ Hope Centre vision, mission and values
- Covid-19 vaccination, required
